

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CARLOW/MAYO**

**BY-LAW NO: 09-2003**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE DATE AND ROADS ON WHICH A  
REDUCED LOAD PERIOD SHALL START.**

**WHEREAS** Chapter H.8, Section 122, subsection (7) of the Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O., 1990) as amended provides that:

The Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

**AND WHEREAS** the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of all highways in the Township of Carlow/Mayo which are under the jurisdiction of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Carlow/Mayo.


**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Carlow/Mayo **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. The provisions of subsections 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act apply to all highways named hereunder, with the start or end of the reduced load period to be at the discretion of the Road Superintendent based on weather and road conditions, inclusive in each and every year:

**ALL OR ANY MUNICIPAL ROAD OR ROADS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP  
OF CARLOW/MAYO.**

2. This by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected and are on display in accordance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act.
3. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 125, subsections (1-4 inclusive) of the Highway Traffic Act and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
4. This by-law repeals any and all previous by-laws and/or motions pertaining to same.
