Council meetings have been changed to the **second Tuesday of the month** and start at 9 a.m. All meetings are held at the Municipal Office located at 3987 Boulter Road and are open to the public. Should it be necessary to change the time and/or date of the meeting, a notice will be placed on the township website, Cunningham's Country Store and at the waste disposal sites. In order for individuals to address Council a Public Forum is scheduled at every council meeting from 9:15 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

A portion of Boulter Road (just north of A. Guy Wilson Road) will be closed for approximately two weeks at the beginning of August. A detour will be set up through A. Guy Wilson and Kuno Road. This project will be funded by the \$25,000.00 we received through the Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund.

Council and staff are pleased to announce the success in receiving a \$32,500.00 grant from the Government of Canada's Enabling Accessibility Fund to help with renovations to the Municipal Office. The renovations include a new cement accessibility ramp with railings, an automatic door, a new accessibility washroom and a new accessibility counter.

A New Horizons for Seniors grant in the amount of \$14,944.00 was also received by the municipality. This funding was used towards the costs of installing automatic accessible doors at both community centres and to purchase seating at community centre playgrounds and at the Foster Lake Park playground.

FIRE BANS –When a Fire Ban is in effect notices will be posted at our municipal office, both municipal waste sites, Cunningham's Country Store, Carlow Community Centre, Mayo Community Centre and on our web-site. What does a Fire Ban mean? A fire ban means absolutely **NO OPEN AIR BURNING**. You cannot have a camp fire for cooking or warmth, you may not set off fireworks, you may not burn garbage, etc. If you have any questions please contact the municipal office.

If no Fire Ban is in effect then the regular rules apply. **April 1 to October 31** there is **NO DAY BURNING PERMITTED** (except for cooking or warmth). Burning is **ONLY** allowed between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. **PLEASE WATCH WHAT AND WHERE YOU BURN!**

The Township of Carlow/Mayo does not have a fire department. The Township of Carlow/Mayo does have a Municipal Forest Fire Management Agreement with the Ministry of Natural Resources to extinguish grass, brush and forest fires. If you have or see a fire please call 9-1-1 for the appropriate authorities to be notified.

The Corporation of the Township of Carlow/Mayo is in the process of updating the Zoning By-law for the Township of Carlow/Mayo. This update is intended to bring the previous Zoning By-law, passed in 2004, up to date with the County of Hastings Official Plan. Upon completion of a new Draft Zoning By-law, the Council of the Township of Carlow/Mayo will hold a Public Open House and a Statutory Public Meeting under the provisions of Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990. Residents are encouraged to regularly check the Township website, local paper or ask to be notified by the Township office when a date and time is scheduled. Upon the scheduling of a date and time for the Public Open House and Statutory Public Meeting, the draft updated Zoning By-law will be available for review and members of the public will have an opportunity to ask questions and provide comments on the document.

The Township of Carlow/Mayo's Tax Program posts all tax payments to any outstanding interest first, then to oldest outstanding amounts as recommended in government legislation. Payments may be made at the municipal office by cash, cheque, or debit. You may also pay your taxes at your financial institution. For your convenience we have a mail slot in the front door of our municipal office. If your payment is not received by the due date you will be charged interest.
