

2017-2018 Road Project

The Township of Carlow/Mayo will receive up to \$1,900,000.00 from the Province's Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund (OCIF) towards the rehabilitation of Boulter Road from the intersection of Whytes Road and Boulter Road to the border line between Carlow/Mayo and Hastings Highlands. The rehabilitation will include correcting cross slope and wheel rutting issues; improving drainage with ditching and new culverts; shouldering; widening in isolated locations and improving road base and resurfacing. The entire project will cost approximately \$2,339,701 and will take two years to complete.

Fire Prevention Reminder

The Township of Carlow/Mayo does not have a fire department. The Township of Carlow/Mayo does have a Municipal Forest Fire Management Agreement with the Ministry of Natural Resources to extinguish grass, brush and forest fires. If you have or see a fire please call 9-1-1 for the appropriate authorities to be notified.

FIRE BANS –When a Fire Ban is in effect notices will be posted at our municipal office, both municipal waste sites, Cunningham's Country Store, Carlow Community Centre, Mayo Community Centre and on our web-site. What does a Fire Ban mean? A fire ban means absolutely No Open Air Burning. You cannot have a camp fire for cooking or warmth, you may not set off fireworks, you may not burn garbage, etc. If no Fire Ban is in effect then the regular rules apply. April 1 to October 31 there is No Day Burning Permitted (except for cooking or warmth). Burning is only allowed between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. Please watch what and where you burn!

Fire can spread quickly and when you least expect it. You may only have a few minutes to escape. That is why the Ontario Fire Code requires that all homes in Ontario have working smoke alarms. A smoke alarm on every level of your home can alert you and your family and provide you with the chance to escape. Remember, installing and maintaining smoke alarms is not only a good idea—it's the law. A working smoke alarm can double your chances of escaping a fire.

It is law in Ontario to install CSA-approved CO alarms outside sleeping areas. CO alarms are required by law to be replaced within the time frame indicated in the manufacturer's instructions and/or on the label on the unit.

Your Municipal Office does have CO /Fire Alarms for sale.
