TOWNSHIP OF CARLOW/MAYO, ONTARIO – Daryl Kramp, Member of Parliament for Prince Edward-Hastings and Chair of the Standing Committee on Public Safety and National Security met with staff and municipal representatives in the hamlet of Boulter to celebrate the successful grant application for the renovation of a barrier free washroom to be installed at the Municipal office.
