A proposed by-law to stop up, to close and to sell to the abutting landowners those lands and premises more particularly described as Lot 12, Concession 1, geographic Township of Carlow, Part 1 on Reference Plan 21R-25820, Township of Carlow/Mayo, County of Hastings.

Proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment

To rezone the retained lands from the Rural (RU) Zone to the Rural Residential (RR) Zone. To rezone the severed lands from the Rural (RU) Zone to a site specific Rural Residential (RR-12) Zone to recognize the meditation retreat facility and existing buildings only.

The site is located in Part of Lot 21, Concession 15, formerly in the geographic Township of Mayo, now in the Township of Carlow/Mayo, County of Hastings. The property has an area of approximately 14.6 acres. The property is currently designated 'Rural-Waterfront and Environmental Protection' in the Hastings County Official Plan and zoned 'Rural (RU) and Environmental Protection (EP)' in Zoning By-Law Number 33-2004.

No person in attendance made any verbal statement either in support of or in opposition to the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment.

Planning staff of Hastings County have no objection to the proposed zoning by-law amendment.
