Question: Is there a polling station?

Answer: No, voting will take place by Internet or Telephone for the October 24, 2022, Municipal Elections. There will be **no** vote by mail.

Voting Period: beginning October 11 at 10:00 a.m. through to October 24 at 8:00 p.m.

A Voter Information Letter will be mailed directly to electors in the month of October, providing a voter with a website address/telephone number(s) and a secure PIN which will allow individuals to vote 24 hours a day beginning Tuesday, October 11, 2022.

If members of the public wish to come into the Municipal office to use a laptop or a device that is set up for Electronic Voting, they may do so during Voter Help Centre Hours:

- Tuesday, October 11, 2022, from 10:00 A.M. - 5:00 p.m.
- Wednesday, October 12, to Thursday, October 13, 2022, from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, October 17, 2022 to Thursday, October 20, 2022, from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, October 24, 2022, Election Day from 8:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
